OFFICIAL MATTERS

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE

Some Unofficial Practice sessions will be offered each day Friday 23 through to Monday 26 October. The exact timing of sessions cannot be confirmed until after the competition schedule has been finalised.

The cost for the practice sessions will be:

Singles: \$15 per 30 minute session

Dance: \$30 per couple per 30 minute session

Synchro: \$100 per team half hour
