2022 GLENBURN FIGURE SKATING CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

This competition is a NZ Nationals qualifying event

- DATES:** Saturday 6th August 4.30pm - 8.30pm
Sunday 7th August 7.15am - 10.15am and 4.30pm - 8.30pm
- VENUE:** Paradise Ice Rink, Lansford Crescent, Avondale www.paradice.co.nz
- CLOSE:** Closing date for entries is Sunday 24th July at 1pm or once the schedule is full whichever is sooner. No late entries will be accepted after this time.
- DRAW:** In accordance with NZIFSA rule 213, the starting order will be randomly computer generated on Sunday 31st July and published on the NZIFSA website at least 24 hours prior to the competition start time. For the second segment of an event (where there is more than one segment) the skating order shall be the reverse of the competitors' placements from the first segment.
- ENTRIES:** Entries must be made on an official online entry form and will only be accepted on payment of the appropriate fee. Entries will only be accepted upon payment of the appropriate fee.

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must be a member of an NZIFSA affiliated club. If you have not yet joined a club, please feel free to talk to us about arranging a membership.

NZIFSA grade skaters (other than NZIFSA KiwiSkate grade) must hold NZIFSA Test and Competition (TC) registration by the close of entries date. Online PPC's must be current.

Skate School entrants must have been enrolled in a Skate School Class or other KiwiSkate class (or equivalent) in the previous 24 months and have completed a minimum of KiwiSkate Basic badge level, with the exception of the Skate School Character division for which there are no specific requirements.

GENERAL COMPETITION REGULATIONS

All NZIFSA grades will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2022 for programme requirements by grade. These can be viewed on the NZIFSA website <http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/rules/>, see; Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200) section. For clarity, in accordance with NZIFSA rule 203, ISU Programme requirements (where applicable) for the 2022/2023 season will apply to this competition.

NZIFSA Test requirements apply at the close of entries. Skaters will not be permitted to skate in a grade for which they do not hold the required tests.

All NZIFSA Singles grades Junior and below will be divided into 3 categories: Ladies (12 & Over), Men (12 & Over), and Under 12 in accordance with Rule 224.1.

COMPETITION MUSIC

All competitors shall provide music electronically in MP3 format. Music files must be uploaded (if they haven't already been uploaded this season) using the following form no later than the close of entries Sunday 24th July 2022

Each file must contain only one track and each track must be named with competitor's full name, grade entered, programme type (Short Programme/Dance, Free Programme/Dance etc), and the exact running time (ie not skating time) of the track as follows:

Skaters are strongly advised to have a copy of their music on USB at the competition as backup.

PLANNED PROGRAMME CONTENT (PPC)

All NZIFSA grade events (excluding Interpretive), current PPC's are required to validate your entry. Please ensure your PPC is entered or current on the NZIFSA website

<http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/members/mynzifsa/ppc.php> no later than the close of entries (Sunday 24th July).

Entries will not be accepted if PPC is not updated or recently verified and entry fee may be forfeited.

Please ask your coach to check your online PPC for you if you have any doubt. KiwiSkate entries must submit their planned programme content using the appropriate form to the competition organisers by close of entries.

CALCULATION OF RESULTS

All NZIFSA grades will be judged under the International Skating Union Judging System (IJS). Final results will be posted online as soon as possible at the conclusion of the competition. Skate School Grades will be judged by majority.

SCHEDULING

A preliminary Schedule for the competition will be posted on the NZIFSA website as soon as possible following the close of entries. Please note the competition schedule may change up to and including the day of the competition. Check your email or updates posted on the NZIFSA and/or Glenburn website/Facebook page.

Whilst every effort will be made to ensure this event takes place as planned, the organisers accept no responsibility for losses or inconvenience associated with any alterations or changes to the planned schedule. The competition may run up to 30 minutes earlier or later than published. Please ensure you allow adequate time to deal with any contingencies.

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

Individuals wishing to video skaters will be required to sign a Video Permit log at registration. Holders of a video permit will be limited to recording the performance of the skater for whom the permit is granted. Persons who wish to video skaters other than their own children, must obtain written permission from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photography or VIDEO-LIGHTS is not permitted during warm-ups or events.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to first (gold), second (silver) and third (bronze) place winners in each category. In addition, all participants will receive a certificate. Perpetual trophies (retained by the winner for one year and then returned) are awarded in some championship grades and for the following additional categories: "Most Promising skater", "Best Artistic Performance", "Most Outstanding Performance"

NOTE: Entrants do not need to be full financial members of GFSC. However, in the event that a guest skater wins a grade, then the trophy, if any, will not be awarded. GFSC welcomes new full financial members. Memberships received before the date of draw will be eligible.
