EVENTS, ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

SINGLES:

Kiwiskate, Pre Elementary, Elementary
Juvenile to Intermediate Novice
Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior
These grades shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 12, Ladies (12 & Over) and Men (12 & Over).

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

The OSISSA retains the rights for any video recording of the Championships. Individuals using video devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. A video permit will be issued. Only people who have a video permit may record their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photographs or VIDEO- LIGHTS is not permitted during warm-ups or events
