



## 2023 QISC COMPETITION NOTICES FOR SKATERS

Dear Skaters,

We look forward to welcoming you this Saturday in Queenstown. Here are a few notices that ensure the smooth running of the event, especially if it is your first time at our rink. If you can lend a hand on the day, please sign up to a role, it would be much appreciated. Editable Volunteer Roster attached to this email.

**SCHEDULE** – is up on the Competition Page of the NZIFSA. Keep an eye out for any updates to the schedule as times can change <https://www.nzifsa.org.nz/competitions/> . Remember that a competition can run up to 30 mins early on the day for a variety of reasons so skaters need to be ready with plenty of time to spare.

Prizegiving will be held on the ice after the competition at 12:30.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Only use the carpark when you are attending the rink, do not leave your car in the carpark if you are going on elsewhere. Parking is for 4 hours maximum and includes behind the rink near the tennis courts
- No skating bags to be left or skates to be put on in the café area. Our rink is *very* strict about this. There are benches out in front of the café near the ice, or a changing room is provided upstairs further along -see map below. Please take care on the stairs in skates
- Strictly no food or drinks can be brought into the rink from outside other than water bottles
- There is limited room in the bathrooms so please arrive preferably with hair and make-up already done or use the upstairs changerooms which will have a mirror or two
- There isn't an Unofficial Practice provided at this comp
- Due to the limited space to warm up, so we suggest the area just outside the rink entrance or the park directly next to the rink

- There is to be no flash photography. If you wish to video, you must have permission and a permit available from the front desk.
- Please bring some cash if you would like to buy raffle tickets
