

Queenstown Ice Skating Club 2023 Club Championships Requirements & Eligibility

SINGLES

Development Grade 1 - Skaters may not hold any NZIFSA Free Skating test or Stroking Test. TC Registration is not required. Programme length up to 1 mins 40 seconds

- Waltz jump
- Bunny Hop
- 2 foot spin (min 3 revs)
- Forward Spiral
- Simple step sequence (at least one half the length of the rink)

Development Grade 2 - Skaters may not hold any NZIFSA Free Skating test or Stroking Test. TC Registration is not required, Programme length up to 1 mins 40 seconds

- Waltz jump
- Salchow or Toe Loop
- Upright spin (min 3 revs)
- Spiral
- Simple step sequence (at least one half the length of the rink)

The IJS will NOT be used for the above grades, placing will be determined by majority opinion of the judges.

Kiwiskate, Pre Elementary, Elementary

As per NZIFSA Rule 226.3

Juvenile to Senior As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1, 226.1 & 226.2

Kiwiskate to Junior shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 12, Girls/Women (12 & Over) and Boys/Men (12 & Over).

Adult As per NZIFSA Rule 224.2, 226.5 & 226.6

Youth Interpretive As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1 & 226.4

Note: Athletes MUST have the required tests for the grade they are entering at the close of entries.
