ENTRIES CLOSE:

Monday 21st of July 2025

or when the schedule is full (whichever occurs first).

Any entry and/or payment not received by the closing date will be subject to an additional late entry fee of \$40.

DRAW DATE:

Wednesday 23rd July 2025

No entries will be accepted after the draw has been made.

As per NZIFSA rule 213, the draw for the starting order will be randomly computer generated and will be put up on the NZIFSA website at least 24hrs prior to the start of the competition. For those events where there is more than one segment, the skater's order shall be reverse of the competitors' placements from the first segment.

Current PPC's are required to validate your entry. Please ensure your PPC is updated on NZIFSA website by 5pm on the Monday 21st of July, failure to update your PPC will nullify your entry and the skater will be unable to participate in the event.

NOTES:

- Please refer to the NZIFSA rules for all additional information regarding programmes and other requirements
- Skaters must have passed the required test for the grade they are entering prior to the closing date of the competition.
- Skaters must be members in good standing of a club affiliated to the NZIFSA.
- All grades in Rule 224.1 and 226.3 (except for Senior and Youth Interpretive) shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st of July immediately preceding the championship:
 - Under 12, Girls/Women (12 & Over)
 - Boys/Men (12 & Over).
 - That is, Girls/Women and Boys/Men shall be judged separately, except in the Under 12 categories where they will be judged together.
- KiwiSkate, Pre Elementary will have a fourth category – Under 8 (with under 12 for this grade being aged 8-11)
- Each Adult grade will be split into five divisions,
 - Young Adult Participants aged 18 – 27
 - (I) Participants aged 28 – 37
 - (II) Participants aged 38 – 47
 - (III) Participants aged 48 – 57
 - (IV) Participants aged 58 – 67
 - (V) Participants aged 68+
 - Men and Ladies FS will be judged separately.
 - Adult Synchronized skating and Rhythm Dance have only one division.
 - In Adult Ice Dancing, separate titles are awarded for Pattern, Rhythm Dance and Free Dance events.
 - Adult and Youth interpretive grades will not be divided by gender.

- Photography: No flash photography will be permitted as it may impact on the skater's performance.
- Video Recording: Individuals using recording devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to filming. Video permits will be available on competition days. Only people who have been granted a video permit may record their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, if these skaters are minors, their parents or guardians must give written consent.
- Competition entry fees are non-refundable after the official closing date of this competition unless a medical certificate is supplied.
