CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Thursday 19th June 2025, no later than 5pm

EVENTS, ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

SINGLES:

Kiwiskate, Pre Elementary, Elementary
Juvenile to Intermediate Novice
Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior

As per NZIFSA Rule 226.3

As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1 & 226.2

As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1, 226.1 & 226.2.

All grades in Rule 224.1 shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 12, Girls (12 & Over) and Boys (12 & Over). That is, Girls and Boys shall be judged separately except when aged under 12. KiwiSkate and Pre Elementary will have a fourth category, Under 8 (with Under 12 for this grade being aged 8-11).

Adult (shall not be divided by gender)

As per NZIFSA Rule 224.2, 226.5 & 226.6

Youth Interpretive (shall not be divided by gender)

As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1 & 226.4

NOTE 1 - Youth Interpretive and Singles Free Skate cannot be entered simultaneously in the same regional competition.

NOTE 2 - : Athletes MUST have the required tests for the grade they are entering at the close of entries.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The OSISSA Ice Figure Skating Championships will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2025. These are posted on the NZIFSA website <https://www.nzifsa.org.nz/rules/>

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

The OSISSA retains the rights for any video recording of the Championships. Individuals using video devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. A video permit will be issued. Only people who have a video permit may record their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photographs or VIDEO- LIGHTS is not permitted during warm-ups or events.
