Entries:	Entries must be made on an official online entry form and will only be accepted upon payment of the appropriate fee. Click here to enter
Technical Requirements:	As per current NZIFSA Rules & Regulations for 2025 NZIFSA: Rules & Regulations (200 and 600 sections).
Other Requirements:	At close of entries, all New Zealand competitors must be current members of a club affiliated to the NZIFSA and be TC Registered unless competing in Skating Academy grades.
Results:	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all IJS Divisions (The IJS will not be used for skating academy or open solo free dance grades, placing will be determined by majority opinion of the judges). Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segments Referee and Technical Controller.
Event Officials:	Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data Operators & Video Replay Operators will be nominated by the organizing committee in conjunction with the NZIFSA Officials' Director and chosen from the approved NZIFSA list of officials for 2026.
Late Entries & Refunds:	Late entries will not be accepted. Refunds upon withdrawal after the closing date are at the discretion of the GFSC committee in accordance with NZIFSA Rule 206.

The above singles grades (apart from Senior) shall be divided into the following categories according to the skater's age as at 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 8 (Kiwiskate and Pre-Elementary Only), Under 12, Women/Girls (12 & Over) and Men/Boys (12 & Over). That is, Women/Girls and Men/Boys shall be judged separately except when aged under 12.

Where grades are POA: please enter online and you will be contacted by the organiser and given a price subject to available officials - if a panel is unavailable this will be offered as an Exhibition Skate.

Adult grades: Minimum age 18 years as at 1 July 2026 - no maximum age limit. Each Adult grade will be split into six divisions, (Young Adult) 18 - 27 (I) 28 - 37 years of age, (II) 38 - 47 years of age, (III) 48 - 57 years of age, (IV) 58 - 67 years of age, and (V) 68 and over.

Age categories for Bronze, Silver, Gold and Elite grades are divided up as per NZIFSA Rules & Regulations for Freeskate, Interpretive, Pairs, Solo Dance and Dance events as detailed above.

Interpretive grades: Adult Interpretive and Youth Interpretive grades shall not be divided by gender.

Music:	<p>All competitors shall provide music electronically in MP3 format. Music files must be uploaded (if they haven't already been uploaded this season) using the following form no later than the close of entries Sunday 5th July 2026.</p> <p>Click here to upload music</p> <p>Each file must contain only one track and each track must be named with competitor's full name, grade entered, programme type (Short Programme/Dance, Free Programme/Dance etc), and the exact running time (ie not skating time) of the track as follows:</p> <p>Jane Smith Juvenile Girls Free Skate 2.13</p> <p>Skaters are strongly advised to have a copy of their music on USB at the competition as backup.</p>
PPCs:	<p>Current PPC's are required to validate entry for all non interpretive grades. For NZIFSA skaters: Please ensure your PPC is updated on NZIFSA website by close of entries. For all Kiwiskate skaters and Synchronised teams: Please complete a form by close of entries and email to glenburncompetition@gmail.com.</p> <p>The PPC form can be located on the NZIFSA Competitions GFSC page</p>
Video Recording and Photography:	<p>Individuals wishing to video skaters will be required to sign a Video Permit log at registration (or click here to complete). Holders of a video permit will be limited to recording the performance of the skater for whom the permit is granted. Persons who wish to video skaters other than their own children, must obtain written permission from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of flash photography or video lights is not permitted during warm ups or events.</p>
Medals & Trophies:	<p>Medals will be awarded to first (gold), second (silver) and third (bronze) place winners in each category. Trophies, if any, will be awarded to GFSC members.</p>
