Note:

- All tests are organised by North Island Ice Skating Sub-Association (NIISSA).
- Only fully completed test forms, signed by an accredited coach and with full payment direct credited, will be accepted and placed on a test. Any discussions held with the test co-ordinator or club representative shall never be considered as a reserved place.
- PPC forms for Free Skates must also be emailed to the Test Coordinator prior to the test date.
- Submission of this form is taken that the skater is prepared for the test and will be placed on the next available test date. Should a skater decline the date due to not being prepared, they will be withdrawn and placed at the back of the queue.
- Where the test is full, the skater will be placed in the queue for the next available date, additional test dates may be added where feasible.
- If a skater withdraws from a test less than 14 days from the test date, the ice fees paid are non-refundable except for illness or injury when a doctor's certificate is supplied.
- The fees are calculated as a minimum charge, additional ice time used will be charged on a user pays basis.
- Due to time limitation Coaches are requested to prepare the Skater to perform the stroking test according to the set patterns and execute with minimum guidance from the judges.
