Accountant and Calc Operator Training – online session, 4 & 5 May. This was attended by four officials and moderated by Ina Paul.

Synchronized Skating - Judge & Technical Seminar plus DO/RO and Calc Operator Training.

Christchurch 18 & 19 May. Rebecca Andrew from Australia was the moderator for the judges seminar and Sandra Williamson-Leadley was the moderator for the Technical Specialists / Technical Controllers. Philippe Maitrot, the chair of the ISU SYS Technical Committee joined us online for a portion of the session to talk through the proposed changes that will be considered at Congress. Ina Paul moderated the Calc Operator training and Vicki Smith provided some support around the DO/RO. The training was attended by 25 officials made up of 12 judges (incl. 2 probationary), 7 Technical Specialists (incl. 4 probationary), 1 DO/RO and 5 Calc Operators (incl. 4 probationary).

JUNIOR GRAND PRIX ALLOCATIONS

The ISU have advised which Junior Grand Prix competitions we have been allocated for the 2024/25 season:

1st event Riga / Latvia, 28-31 August Men

3rd event Bangkok / Thailand, 11-14 September Men, Women

4th event Istanbul / Turkey, 18-21 September Men 5th event Gdansk / Poland, 25-28th September Men 6th event Ljubljana / Slovenia 2-5 October Men

7th event Wuxi / China, 9-12 October Men, Women

Dwayne Li has already confirmed that he wishes to attend the JGP in Bangkok and Wuxi. The priority for the Women's places at the Bangkok and Wuxi JGP and qualification for any of the remaining spots we have been allocated for Men will be determined after the Clucas Cup.

CALL FOR TEAM LEADERS FOR JUNIOR GRAND PRIX COMPETITIONS

The NZIFSA are seeking expressions of interest from suitably experienced individuals to fulfil the Team Leader role at the following JGP events:

- Junior Grand Prix Bangkok, Thailand, 11-14 September
- Junior Grand Prix Wuxi, China, 9-12 October

For all events with 2 or more skaters a skater's coach or parent will not normally be named as Team Leader.

We are looking for team leaders who have enough experience of international competitions, ideally either as an official or coach, to be able to coordinate the activities of our team members. As outlined in the position description, they need to be able to handle crisis situations as well as routine administrative tasks; be team players who can work with all athletes, coaches, judges, parents, and administrators; have knowledge of the NZIFSA rules and agreements surrounding international participation; and, have local knowledge that well assist them in carrying out their role.

The NZIFSA Funding Policy https://nzifsa.org.nz/rules/Funding%20Policy%20%20V11.pdf section 10, outlines two different maximum funding criteria based on the location of each ISU Championship or International as indicated below:

- For events in North/South America, Asia and Oceania, \$1,650 plus cost of official accommodation if not provided by ISU for official days of competition
- For events in Europe and South Africa, \$2,750 plus cost of official accommodation if not provided by ISU for official days of competition

Normally a person may be selected for a team leader position only once per funding season, however if circumstances require an individual to serve as team leader at more than one competition, funding will be provided in all cases.

CLUCAS CUP (SELECTION COMPETITION), DUNEDIN 15 & 16 JUNE 2024

NZIFSA is hosting the Clucas Cup Selection Competition at Dunedin Ice Stadium, with the support of DISC. This competition is to establish the priority of assignment for International A and B skaters to competitions whose entries close between 7 July and 1 week after the completion of the 2024 New Zealand National Championships. Any skaters who were selected to the International A or B team at our 2023 National Championships still retain their selection for international competitions with a closing date one week after our 2024 National Championships, provided they are still age eligible at 1 July 2024. Priority order for competitions may change as a result of Clucas Cup results.

NZIFSA are also looking forward to the presentation of the Clucas Cup in memory of Wendy Clucas, and presented by her daughters Janine and Sonja. The cup will be awarded to the skater that gains the highest percentage above the A team Selection TES, with the highest unfactored programme component score as the deciding factor if there is a draw.

Provisional selections will be announced within 48 hours of the conclusion of the Selection Competition and will be confirmed within one week. Please see the NZIFSA Selection Policy for Opportunities for Selection and Prioritising of Skaters, Selection Criteria for International Representatives and Selection of skaters for Novice (Basic, Intermediate and Advanced), Junior and Senior International events.

Our National Championships signal the reset of our international representative selections. Any skaters wishing to compete in international competitions whose entries close more than 1 week after the NZ National Championships, need to gain selection at our National Championships. Selection of International A and B Representatives will be announced within 48 hours of the conclusion of the 2023 NZIFSA National Championships or at the social function afterwards.

Just a reminder that if you wish to compete in any competition outside New Zealand, you need to request permission from the NZIFSA via the General Secretary <u>secretary@nzifsa.org.nz</u> before you enter the competition. For most international competitions the entries will need to be done through the ISU Online Registration System by the NZIFSA Test/Competition Secretary.

MUSIC DETAILS REQUIRED FOR MUSIC LICENSING

In preparation for the 2024 competition season we need everyone to provide or update your music details to help ensure we can meet our music licensing requirements.

For all club and regional competitions in the South Island and for the Clucas Cup and our National Championships, please use the NZIFSA form.

NOTE: The North Island Ice Skating Sub Association (NIISSA) has chosen to manage the music information using a separate system for North Island club and regional competitions that better meets their needs.

What information do you need to provide?

1 General

Skater name(s), email address(s), grade, coach name, coach email address. Please update coach contact details if this has changed.

Note, only one form needs to be completed for ice dance couples and pairs teams. For synchro teams we ask for the team manager and coach contact details.

2 What competitions and grade are you entering?

Please mark which competitions you are entering and pick the correct grade from the drop down menu. This helps the competition organisers when checking that they have your music details. You can come back and update this again later with any additional competitions you enter, or if you move up grades during the year.

3 The music details.

For each programme you skate you will need to provide the following for each piece of music used

- Title of Music
- Recording Artist(s)
- Composer(s)
- Publisher / Record Label
- Duration of cut (min:sec e.g. 1:40)
- Whether vocal or non-vocal (instrumental)

We suggest you collect this information for each piece music before you start filling in the form. If you are trying to find the details, we recommend you find your piece of music in Spotify, click on the 3 dots ... for extra information and choose "Show credits".

Saving and updating the form

You need to click the save button at the bottom right of the form before you exit. The skater and coach will both be sent an email called "2023 Music details Save & Resume Link". With this link you will be able to go back and update details, including entry to additional competitions or changes to the music details recorded.

Separate forms for different events

If a skater is competing more than one event, e.g. Dance and Singles, or Interpretive and Singles, then separate forms need to be completed. This is so that we can check that we have the required music details for any given competition. But if you compete in an event that has more than one part to it – e.g a Short Programme and a Freeskate, you can enter this information in the one form.

Often we find they are four of five years out of date and we may have a skater aged fifteen with a photo of them at age ten.
