RESIGNATION OF SANDRA WILLIAMSON-LEADLEY - HIGH PERFORMANCE OFFICER

A change in the ISU Code of Ethics (ISU Com 2589) means that ISU judges are now unable to hold a position in their Federation and still be eligible to judge at ISU events. Unfortunately, this has necessitated Sandra having to resign from her role as High Performance Officer or forgo any opportunity to Judge at ISU events. This is a significant blow to NZIFSA as we have benefited hugely from her willingness to share her knowledge and expertise, however, Sandra really was left with no other reasonable course of action. NZIFSA will be sending a letter to the ISU highlighting the impact that this decision has on small member federations like NZIFSA.

WORLD ICE SKATING DAY – SUNDAY 3 DECEMBER

Mark this date in your calendar now and look out for activities that might be happening in your area. The World Ice Skating Day (WISD), created and organized by the International Skating Union (ISU), is a one-day global festival dedicated to Ice Skating. This year's annual celebration will be held on December 3, 2023. The key objectives are to make Ice Skating sports accessible to everyone in a fun and safe environment — for first-timers, amateurs, professionals or retired skaters. NZIFSA will be following up on earlier communication with clubs and rinks to support any activities they have planned.

SITUATIONS STILL VACANT – IJS TECHNICAN

The IJS Technician is responsible for the maintenance, setup, troubleshooting and teardown of the International Skating Union (ISU) <u>International Judging System (IJS)</u>.
