

## Appendix C:

### Gaining Coach Continuing Education Points to Maintain Accreditation

The following activities will enable coaches to earn the required Continuing Education Points in order to maintain their current level of NZIFSA Coach Accreditation. Proof of attendance to all courses is required to be sent to the Coaching Director alongside the log book.

Points required per year (1 April to 31 March):

- KiwiSkate Assistant            5 points
- KiwiSkate Coach            5 points
- Introduction to Coaching        10 points
- Level 1                                15 points
- Level 2                                25 points
- Level 3                                25 points
